Two Far East Organization Developments awarded in the Best Residential Development category at MIPIM Asia Awards 2015

Singapore, 1 December 2015 – Far East Organization’s (“远东机构”) luxury developments, Altez and Silversea, were awarded Silver and Bronze respectively in the Best Residential Development category of the prestigious MIPIM Asia Awards 2015. The two projects were among 36 finalists shortlisted in 12 award categories. The ranking, as a result of votes from the jury and MIPIM Asia delegates, were announced during the MIPIM Asia Awards 2015 Gala Dinner held at the Grand Hyatt Hotel Hong Kong this evening.

In its 9th edition, the MIPIM Asia Awards recognises outstanding real estate projects in Asia Pacific for their architectural, technical and environmental excellence and innovation. This year, the Awards received over 100 entries from 17 countries and regions.

Altez | Silver, Best Residential Development

Strategically located amidst the new wave of exciting developments in downtown Tanjong Pagar, Altez consists of a 62-storey, 280-unit residential tower, complemented by commercial development on the first storey. Towering at 250 metres, Altez takes high-rise inner-city liveability to new heights with five lifestyle sky gardens and two floors of facilities. Altez is set in the midst of a rapidly transforming Greater Southern Waterfront precinct earmarked to be the Waterfront City of the future brimming with exciting commercial and housing developments.



Silversea | Bronze, Best Residential Development

Straddling one of the last available sites along Singapore's Eastern shoreline, Silversea offers stunning sea views set amidst the East Coast's quaint mix of old world charms and cosmopolitan vibes. Occupying a 20,000 sqm site, the 383-unit Silversea plays up its seaward facing, its best feature, with glass sheathed towers for a floor-to-ceiling view of the horizon. 60% of the land, over



and above the typical 40%, has been devoted to lush grounds and provision of a full suite of amenities. A sky promenade on the 11th floor links the development's two sets of 21-storey towers, creating sky-high clubhouses with panoramic views to be savoured from infinity-edged dip pools.

The awards cap a year of accolades received by Far East Organization as it commemorates its 55th Anniversary in 2015. Far East Organization clinched four awards in the FIABCI Singapore Property Awards 2015 for Silversea, Altez and Discovery Walk on Orchard (Retail and Specialised Project categories). Far East Organization also garnered seven awards at the South East Asia Property Awards 2015 including Best Developer in South East Asia and Singapore and Best Green Development in South East Asia and Singapore for its commercial development SBF Center.
